Council Meeting Minutes

Members present: All council members were present. Also present was Richard Gorman.

Motion by Fritz Schulz, seconded by Jerry Warren to approve the agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion made by Tia Schimek, seconded by Fritz Schulz to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2011 council meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion made by Tia Schimek, seconded by Jerry Warren to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2011 public hearing. Motion Carried.

With respect to old business, Councilman Schulz gave a report on the status of the Stehr sand operation. Councilman Schulz gave a recommendation that council go forward, wherein Stehr's agreed to level the east and north sides of their property to a reasonable grade and that will make the property safer. Going forward, we will reevaluate the situation and see if a fence needs to be erected based upon the size of the open pit area and any slope issues. Councilman Schulz also indicated there was an accumulation of black top on the property, most of which did not come from the City of Goodhue. The City of Goodhue will be requesting the Stehr's to remove that material.

Motion made by Leia Ryan, seconded by Jerry Warren to pay half the proceeds of a gas locator which is used by city maintenance help and the City of Goodhue Gas Commission. Motion Carried

The city engineer gave us an update on the water tower project. The water tower should begin being put up in the next couple of weeks.

The city engineer also gave an update on the feasibility on the front street improvement, which would improve the alley between the C-store and Lodermeier's property. Motion by Tia Schimek, seconded by Fritz Schulz to order the report. Motion Carried.

In addition, there was a motion by Leia Ryan, seconded by Jerry Warren to receive the report and set a public hearing for June 15, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall. All applicable property owners will be notified.

Mr. Gorman then indicated to the council that he had contact with Jennifer Fox regarding the trailer home property. We were concerned with trailer #8 and also with trailer #41, also with respect to her outstanding charges. The Council then directed Attorney Gorman to contact Fox and bring these matters to a head.

There was Motion by Leia Ryan, seconded by Fritz Schulz to pay all bills. Motion Carried.

Finally, there was a Motion by Leia Ryan, seconded by Jerry Warren to adjourn. Motion Carried.
