

**CITY OF GOODHUE
MINUTES OF THE GOODHUE CITY COUNCIL MEETING
OF AUGUST 14, 2019**

The regular meeting of the City Council for the City of Goodhue was held on August 14, 2019, at City Hall. All members were present except Rick Buck.

Mayor Kerry D. Bien called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. The Council and audience all stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Wayne Hahn, and seconded by Tia Schimek to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

There was a motion by Tia Schimek and seconded by Tom Haugen to approve the minutes of the July 24, 2019, meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Under old business, Richard Gorman gave an update on the appraisal and is hoping to have it by the next meeting, but the appraiser simply does not have it done yet.

Under new business, Richard Gorman gave an update on the Verizon Cell Tower Contract which is coming due in 2022. The current amount paid per month is \$1,838.00. The council gave Richard Gorman the authority to go ahead and negotiate with Verizon for a new cell tower contract.

Selena O'Reilly gave an update on the Farmers' Market activities. She was very happy with the progress and hopes the success will continue in the future.

The Mayor raised some concerns about the conditions of some properties in the City of Goodhue. The Police have followed up with those conditions and will write citations if the conditions continue. The Mayor also reported that the mowing was done in the new addition. However, the project is still not ready to be closed out because the grass is not growing.

A motion by Tom Haugen and seconded by Wayne Hahn to pay the current bills. Motion passed unanimously.

There was a motion by Tia Schimek, seconded by Wayne Hahn to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting was then adjourned at 7:43 p.m.
